RULES/ EXPECTATIONS

- The contestant must be a naturally born female and reside, go to school (this includes homeschoolers), or hold property in Grapeland, TX
- Contestants or Contestants' parents (if the child is under 18 years of age) affirm that she is and will continue to be a person of good character.
- Must be in good academic standing with your school on the date of the pageant.
- Contestants are only allowed to miss two of the practices offered before they are removed from the pageant.
- Contestants are also required to present their talent act in full before the date of the pageant.
- Contestants will not be allowed to change their talent once it is approved and finalized by the directors. Meaning what you show us is what you will perform on the night of the pageant.
- Contestants must attend at least two community service events offered.
- Contestants must dress in appropriate attire at all pageant-related events. The dress code will be determined by the pageant directors.
- Contestants should professionally conduct themselves at all times during and outside of the pageant. No loud talking, boisterous, or rude manners will be tolerated.
- Contestants are required to find a sponsor/sponsors to help with expenses.
- All contestants are required to enter a float in the parade. Floats must be covered in floral sheeting, and if this is not possible, contestants should use the alternative of riding in a classic car.
- Contestants are required to help construct their float.
- Contestants will also be required to submit progress photos of their float to ensure that they will meet the parade float guidelines.
- Contestants and Contestants' Supporters, Guests, or Visitors, will conduct themselves respectfully and professionally at all times during the pageant. Bad sportsmanship is NOT tolerated and will be grounds for removal of the Contestant from the pageant.
- The contestant promises not to slander the Pageant, its directors, peers, judges, volunteers, or anyone else affiliated with the pageant.
- The contestant and the Contestants' parents or legal guardians agree to abide by eligibility requirements and affirm that all information provided is true
- One adult only is permitted in the dressing room for contestants.
- No boys or men are allowed in dressing rooms at any time not even fathers. NO EXCEPTIONS.
- Smoking/Vaping is not allowed.
- Alcohol is not allowed to be consumed by anyone throughout the pageant
- Drugs are not allowed period.
- The contestant agrees if selected as the Pageant Queen titleholder at no time will she smoke cigarettes, drink alcohol, or partake of illegal substances while wearing her crown and/or banner. A titleholder may not wear her crown and/or banner in public except at appearance opportunities approved by the pageant director.
- Contestants MUST abide by all rules. Parents of any contestant not observing all rules will be contacted and the girl will be sent home without an opportunity to receive the scholarship.

I understand that by signing up for the 2025 Peanut Pageant, I am required as a contestant/Parent or Guardian to abide by all contestant rules/ expectations. If I fail to follow these requirements, I relinquish my right to participate in the pageant. I also affirm that all information provided is true and correct to the best of my knowledge.
