RULES/ EXPECTATIONS

- Contestants must be naturally born female and must either attend Grapeland ISD or be homeschooled while living within Grapeland ISD boundaries. Girls who live in Grapeland ISD but attend another school are not eligible.
- Must be in good academic standing with your school on the date of the pageant.
- Contestants are only allowed to miss two out of all of the practices offered before they are removed from the pageant.
- Contestants are also required to present their talent act in full before the date of the pageant.
- Contestants will not be allowed to change their talent once it is approved and finalized by the directors. Meaning what you show us is what you will perform on the night of the pageant.
- Contestants must attend at least two community service events **if** offered.
- Contestants must dress in appropriate attire at all pageant-related events. The dress code will be determined by the pageant directors.
- Contestants should professionally conduct themselves at all times during and outside of the pageant. No loud talking, boisterous, or rude manners will be tolerated.
- Contestants are required to find a sponsor/sponsors to help with expenses.
- All contestants are required to enter a float in the parade. Floats must be covered in floral sheeting, and additional materials of your choice.
- Contestants are required to help construct their float if applicable.
- Contestants will also be required to submit progress photos of their float to ensure that they will meet the parade float guidelines.
- The contestant promises not to slander the Pageant, its directors, peers, judges, volunteers, or anyone else affiliated with the pageant.
- Only one adult is permitted in the dressing room for contestants. **NO** family members are allowed backstage.
- No boys or men are allowed in dressing rooms at any time – not even fathers. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**
- All contestants promise to be tobacco, drug, and alcohol free. No vaping of any kind is allowed, not even tobacco-free vapes.
- A titleholder may not wear her crown and/or banner in public except at appearance opportunities approved by the pageant director.
- As a winner of the Pageant, I understand that the scholarship will only be presented upon proof of enrollment in a trade school or higher education.
- If selected as the Peanut Queen, you agree to participate in events in the Grapeland Community, including but not limited to: Christmas on Main, The Chamber Banquet, and the following year's Peanut Festival
- Contestants **MUST** abide by all rules. Parents of any contestant not observing all rules will be contacted, and the girl will be sent home without an opportunity to receive the scholarship.

I understand that by signing up for the 2025 Peanut Pageant, I am required as a contestant/Parent or Guardian to abide by all contestant rules/ expectations. If I fail to follow these requirements, I relinquish my right to participate in the pageant. I also affirm that all information provided is true and correct to the best of my knowledge.
