**Registration forms must be completed ONLINE or mailed in by October 10<sup>th</sup> @ 12:00am to receive a number. There will be no registration held the morning of the parade. There will be a table set up in front of the Jr. High to pick up pre-registered numbers. Judging will start promptly at 9:00 for all those with numbers and in all categories.**

1. All vehicles must be driven by a licensed driver.  
ATVs and Cruising bikes are allowed but drivers must be AT LEAST 16 years or older.  
No unsafe driving practices will be tolerated, including burn-outs, wheelies or speed as well as loud pipes or engines. Any participant displaying unsafe driving will be pulled out of the parade by a uniformed officer, ticketed, and banned from future parades.
2. Any entry considered a possible fire hazard by parade chairman, will be required to have a fire extinguisher on board and in sight.
3. What kid doesn't enjoy CANDY?!?! Candy may be tossed but please be considerate of where it is thrown. Far enough away from moving vehicles. We don't want children running into the parade route!!!!
4. Horse entries MUST pre-register according to the above deadline. A current Coggins test (dated not older than 1 yr from the date of the festival) must be presented to an on-sight festival volunteer the morning of the parade. If you don't have such test you must not participate in the parade. (for the safety of the other animals). Riders will also be expected to maintain safe control of their horse for the safety of everyone.
5. Any decisions the Parade Chair should find necessary to make concerning the safety and well-being of the parade and its activities are to be respected and adhered to.
